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Tissue Transplant Benefits

Bone Treatment of patients with orthopedic cancers, damaged spines, trauma and damaged joints

Tendons and ligaments Joint reconstruction and repair of sports injuries

Skin Replacement for burn patients, breast reconstruction following a mastectomy, and treatment of wounds

Veins and arteries Treatment for those suffering from diabetes or other vascular diseases

Heart valves Repair of damaged or diseased heart valves

Corneas Replacement of damaged or diseased corneas to improve eyesight

Facts to Consider

More than 300,000 bone grafts will be used to treat irreversible bone diseases, and traumatic injuries, often saving damaged limbs from amputation.

An estimated 45,000 corneas will be transplanted to restore sight, yet more than 5,000 people will still be waiting for an available cornea at the end of the year.

About 100,000 skin grafts will be performed annually to treat extensive wounds or trauma.
