




Our **Vision**

Each year, Versiti Organ and Tissue supports hundreds of individuals and families through the profound journey of loss while facilitating the life-changing gift of organ and tissue donation. These donor heroes leave behind families and loved ones who carry forward their legacy while coping with the deep grief of their absence. We honor donors and their families for their extraordinary generosity. In the midst of life's most difficult moments, organ, tissue and eye donation shines as a powerful beacon of hope.

Versiti, a federally designated Organ Procurement Organization (OPO), is committed to providing comprehensive support, resources, and guidance to donor families throughout the donation journey. From the hospital to the operating room and beyond, Versiti staff keep families informed about the option of organ and tissue donation, address their questions, and offer compassionate guidance should they choose the gift of life. Once the donation is complete, Versiti continues to offer support through aftercare resources and volunteer opportunities, helping families connect with others who have faced similar hardships.

Rooted in our deep commitment to supporting donor families through their journey of grief and healing, Versiti is devoted to creating meaningful opportunities for donor families and recipients to honor and reflect on the extraordinary gift of life. We believe that these remarkable individuals deserve more than emotional and material support; they deserve a lasting, physical space for remembrance and reflection.

What **We Do**

Founded in 1947 by the Junior League of Milwaukee, Versiti began as a blood center dedicated to connecting blood donors with patients in need of blood transfusions. Over the decades, Versiti expanded its scope and impact, becoming a trusted healthcare partner across Wisconsin and has grown to offer specialized testing, treatment, and research in areas such as hematology, oncology, and cellular therapy.

A major milestone came in 2010 when Versiti widened its mission to include organ and tissue donation. This integrated approach allows Versiti to better serve patients, families, and hospitals through coordinated recovery, evaluation, and transplant services.

Versiti Organ and Tissue (Versiti O&T) is the federally designated organ procurement organization (OPO) and tissue bank for southeastern Wisconsin. It provides comprehensive organ and tissue recovery services, donor management, hospital development, family support, and public and professional education. Versiti O&T is the region's leading source of information about donation and actively works to increase awareness of the ongoing need for organ and tissue donors.

Organ, Tissue & Aftercare Services

The Versiti Organ and Tissue services team partners with 34 hospitals and three transplant centers to coordinate all organ donations across an 11-county designated service area in southeastern Wisconsin. Versiti's tissue bank partners with more than 135 hospitals, medical examiners, and coroners throughout Wisconsin to facilitate tissue donation. From the initial hospital or medical examiner referral through donation and beyond, the team manages donor evaluation, clinical support, recovery coordination, and provides support to donor families and hospital staff. The support for families continues after donation through the Versiti Organ and Tissue Aftercare Program. The program offers donor families resources on grief and loss, donation recognition items, and donation information. Families also have the opportunity to participate in donor family events, memorial programs, and our volunteer program.


